Additional Public Holiday for 2012/13


The Government has announced that there will be an additional Public Holiday on Tuesday 5 June 2012 to celebrate the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

The 2012 late May Bank Holiday will be moved to Monday 4 June and an additional Jubilee Bank Holiday will be on Tuesday 5 June.


In accordance with Part 2, paragraph 7.1 of the Green Book, employees will be entitled to a holiday with a normal day's pay on this additional Public Holiday.



THE QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE BANK HOLIDAYS JUNE 2012

The Government has announced that there will be an additional bank holiday to celebrate Her Majesty The Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

The 2012 late May bank holiday will be moved to Monday 4 June and an additional Jubilee bank holiday will be on Tuesday 5 June. In accordance with Part 2 Para 7.1 of the Green Book, employees will be entitled to a holiday with a normal day's pay on the additional bank holiday.

In schools the May half-term holiday is likely to be moved to the first week in June to coincide with the two bank holidays, with the school year being reduced by one day by closing early for the summer holidays. Despite this reduction in the pupil year to 189 days the salary calculation for term-time only staff should continue to reflect the usual pupil year of 190 days.
